
INSTRUCTION ON BELOVED SAINT GERMAIN'S HONOR CROSS

Beloved K-17:

If I were you, I would be as firm as steel against responding to anyone else's suggestion of imperfection about another person that is in this Light. Each of you is like a cell of a body; and if one does something to another that causes disintegration, then it affects the whole. So if people come to you about other people's faults, say: "Now just don't put that in my world! If it is wrong, we will turn back to the 'Presence' and ask every Power of the Sacred Fire to consume what is wrong and hold the Victory of what is right in its place. But don't expect me to take my time to let you put that into my world!" And you will settle this thing. The 100% Pledge of the "I AM" Students is the whole of the Law.

So, Beloved Ones, if you wear the Honor Cross, remember what It signifies, and remember what Power can be yours as you understand what it means to honor Life with the Love of the Sacred Fire and the Ascended Masters' Perfection to bring God's Victory in and around yourselves, and then expand It by the Sacred Fire everywhere you abide. You will be like a Sun shedding Its Radiance so the rest of mankind can see the way to safety. . . . *The Voice of the "I AM," 79.6:20*

Notice concerning our Honor Cross: Those who wear this Honor Cross of the "I AM" Legions of Honor to God" should remember their Sacred Obligation to the "Beloved I AM Presence," Beloved Saint Germain, and all the Ascended Host. Their personal conduct—public and private—should at all times be *only* such as honors God, honors America, honors all under this Radiation, and honors all that is of the Light everywhere forever.

Wear Them where they are a credit to the Masters. We wear ours whenever the work in hand is that which represents the Constructive Way of Life. They are always for the Class or Group Activities, and are for formal use.

The people in airplanes, trains, and restaurants so often say, "Well, what is that emblem you wear and what does it mean?" And I always give them this answer: "We are the 'I AM' Legions of Honor to God. We place God before anything or anybody in this world. . . ."

. . . I ask everyone, please do not wear our Honor Cross if you cannot give obedience to this Law. Please do not dishonor my Master nor the Love He has given to Life down through the ages. Few understand how long He has loved mankind and how completely and unselfishly He has served, and the least we can do is to either honor Him or not wear His Cross. His Cross is the Open-ended Cross of Freedom to all Life.

Q. Will you please explain the Open-ended Cross?

Mrs. G. W. Ballard:

Yes! The Open-ended Cross is like our Honor Cross. As the arms of the Cross go out, they spread. And that is the Open-ended Cross of Freedom to all Life in the Universe—all above, all below, and all on each side of us. Wherever we abide, we are the Threefold Flame within the Heart of Life, the individualized Heart Flame from the Great Central Sun pouring our Blessing to all things in the Universe. That's the meaning of the Open-ended Cross.

Q. Would you please explain the purpose and the significance of the Honor Cross? Who may wear one, and when may a new Student feel ready to wear one?

Mrs. G. W. Ballard:

The Honor Cross of Beloved Saint Germain is His Open-ended Cross of Freedom. The Flame within is His Violet Flame Mastery—Miracle Mastery over all in this world. Please don't ever wear His Honor Cross unless you have dedicated yourself to Immortal Purity in His Service for the Freedom of the Nation of His Heart and the Service of the Sacred Fire of His All-Purifying, All-Protecting Love that is Immortal Freedom in the Victory of the Ascension. . . . Nobody but a Student who is a 100% Student—and I mean a sincere one—should ever wear this Cross. It's only for those who have dedicated everything to His Service as some return for all the Purity and the Love and the Power He has used through the centuries to bring us this far in the Light and to purify the Earth. . . .

A new Student is only ready to wear it when that one has used enough Violet Consuming Flame to consume the discord and the impurity of the past, understand this Law, give the obedience, hold the harmony, and make the Application for the Freedom of this Nation and the world. . . .

Q. Will you please tell us what should be done with our Honor Cross Pins when we make the Change?

Mrs. G. W. Ballard:

I am very grateful for this question because your Honor Cross was given to you on the conditions that you serve the Light and honor Beloved Saint Germain and His Work; and nobody has any authority to will that to somebody else, because if the other person doesn't wear it with honor, he'll open himself or herself to considerable trouble, because this is a Focus of what Beloved Saint Germain can use to produce Perfection. And if It goes into the hands of destructive persons, or they won't honor It, they draw upon themselves plenty to handle. 650917.1

Mrs. G. W. Ballard:

Now those who have made the Change, if you'll ask me about it, there are those to whom sometimes—the individual wanted a friend to have the Honor Cross. And sometimes it's quite all right for that person to have It. But usually if you'll send It to me, I'll clean It up and have It recharged and ask Beloved Saint Germain to charge It with what the individual to whom It's going—requires the most to give that one the greatest assistance. 590913-1

Q. May we have our Honor Pins engraved with our names?

Mrs. G. W. Ballard:

Some have, Beloved Ones. I do not think it's a good idea for this reason: The Honor Cross really belongs to Beloved Saint Germain, and if people make the Change and that Honor Cross is given to someone else, it's not well to have

the other person's name engraved on the back of It—the person who has passed on. I myself would not do it.

Q. I have a lucite cross—Beloved Saint Germain's Honor Cross, I thought! I have worn it for many years with joy and gratitude. A Student tells me now that only the newer large Crosses with the Heart are considered our official Honor Cross, and only special Students can buy and wear them.

Mrs. G. W. Ballard:

Well, the official Cross of this "I AM" Activity is the Honor Cross—as you see, the violet one in violet enamel with the Flame in the center. Now it doesn't mean that you can't use the others—or love them and bless them and wear them at other times if you want to. But that which represents our Honor Cross is our "I AM" Honor Legions to God. That's what It represents, and no other Cross represents that but ours.

There's no reason—if you have a plastic cross or a lucite cross—I have one that the Youth gave me with a little amethyst in the center, and very often I wear that. But when I'm on official business and representing Beloved Saint Germain in the Activity, I always wear the Honor Cross. That is our official insignia. Now Beloved Saint Germain permitted this to come into existence; He's given us His Protection, and we should never wear It except with honor. And when we can't honor—wear It with honor—we should not wear It at all.
